## **Now the serious stuff:**

### **Travelling by car:**

Travelling North from Edinburgh M9 or Glasgow on M80 or travelling South from Perth M9.

Take exit from either direction from all motorways at Junction 9.

At 1st roundabout take exit sign posted A91 and follow route until next roundabout.

At 2nd roundabout take 2nd exit onto A91 and follow route until next roundabout.

At 3rd roundabout take 1st exit onto A91 and follow route until next roundabout.

At 4th roundabout take 2nd exit onto A91 and follow route until next roundabout.

At 5th roundabout take 2nd exit onto A91 and follow route until next roundabout.

At 6th roundabout take 2nd exit onto Forthside Way and follow route until next roundabout. You should see Express Holiday Inn on right hand side as you drive along.

At 7th roundabout take 3rd exit for East Stand Entrance into Stirling Albion Football Club.

**Please note: Parking is limited on site - see below. \*\***

### **Travelling By Train**

Train is the best form of transport as there is a regular service from most other Scottish cities and towns and Stirling Train Station is located in the city centre with easy access to Binos Live (1.8km) and Stirling Bus Station (400m).

### **Travelling by Bus**

### **Taxi**

If you would prefer to take a taxi from Stirling city centre to Binos Live the taxi rank is located outside Stirling Train Station.

### **Walking**

The distance from the train or bus station to Binos Live is approximately 1.8km.

### **\*\*Parking**

Our hope is that many of you will either travel by bike, by foot or by public transport. However, we do appreciate that there will still be a demand for parking.

In order to reduce demand for parking spaces at the Peak Leisure Centre, we have identified 6 nearby parking areas within a half mile radius of the event, and one (Forthside Way) at 0.7 miles:

- Forthside Way Car Park (The Vue)
- Park and Ride
- St. Modan's High School (blue badge parking)

There are a few other areas we can direct traffic to for parking but would stress that the stores mentioned could have parking restrictions:

- Morrisons
- Springkerse Retail Park
- Homebase

Vehicles are parked in these areas at the owner's risk.

Volunteers, event staff and vendors can park at St. Modan's High School on a first served basis but priority will be given to blue badge holders.

### **Health and Safety**

1. In light of recent terror attacks across the UK we would advise you not to bring large bags to the event. Bags will be subject to checks by security.

2. Only guide dogs will be admitted to the event.
3. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult and are the responsibility of their parent or guardian on site.
4. Photographers will be taking pictures as people arrive at the festival and throughout the day. These are for PR purposes only.
5. Please do not bring your own alcohol into the event.

### **Weather**

The long-term weather forecast is looking good but we can't control the weather so come prepared e.g. waterproof clothing, sunscreen, water etc.

I'm sure you'll agree that nothing will dampen spirits on this wonderful occasion.
